BAD HATS THEATRE is an award-winning Toronto-based independent creative engine for new musical works for audiences of all ages, steered by a three-headed leadership team: Artistic Director Fiona Sauder, Managing and Artistic Producer Matt Pilipiak, and Executive Producer Victor Pokinko. We create new works with music, movement, and story, encouraging audiences of all ages to play, to find the extraordinary within the ordinary, to remember how alive we were as children and engage in that curiosity together (we could all use some practice).

To date, Bad Hats productions have been nominated for twenty-six Dora Mavor Moore Awards, winning thirteen (including three Outstanding New Productions), have played to over 85,000 audience members across Canada, and have forged partnerships with dozens of theatres from province to province.

LANDON DOAK (They/Them) is an award-winning actor and singer-songwriter based in Toronto. They are the Associate Artist of Bad Hats Theatre, a recent Musical Stage Company's Dan Fund recipient, and former faculty at Sheridan College. Writing credits for Bad Hats include: Narnia, Alice in Wonderland, (Dora Award - Outstanding New Musical), Peter Pan (Dora Awards - Outstanding Ensemble, Production), Life in a Box (Dora Award - Outstanding New Musical). Selected other writing credits: Small Gods The Musical (Sheridan College), The 7 Fires (Musical Stage/Aquarius), The Welland Canal Play (Essential Collective Theatre), Robin Hood (The Lakeside Players). They are infinitely grateful for what they do in this life!

FIONA SAUDER (she/they) is a Dora Award winning playwright, director, and performer. She is the co-founder and Artistic Director of Bad Hats Theatre, a Toronto-based company dedicated to the development of new musical works for multigenerational audiences, where she has written Narnia, Alice in Wonderland, Peter Pan, Storybook Search, and Princess Frownsalot. A finalist for the 2024 Gina Wilkinson Prize, Fiona's writing has been presented across Canada. She is thrilled to have new audiences encountering Peter Pan, the big little show that marked the beginning of so many adventures to come.

REANNE SPITZER (she/her). After working in the Toronto theatre industry for nearly a decade, Reanne has found new roots in beautiful Montreal. 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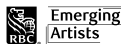

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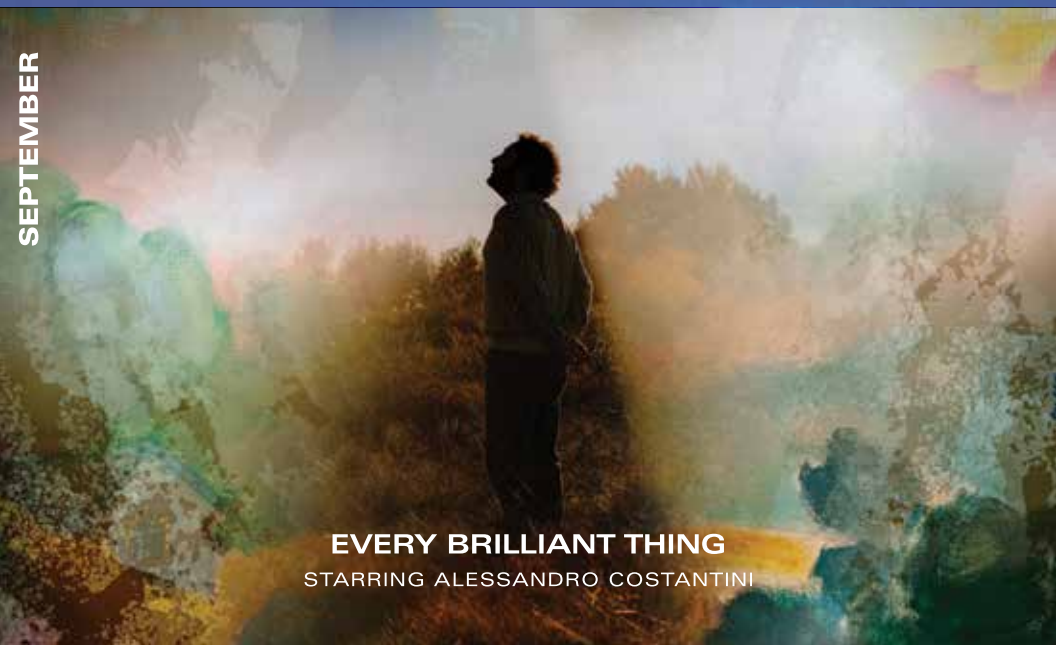
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
